STANDARD OF CONDUCT FORM
(For Junior and Senior High School Students)

Faith Christian School has a passion to see each student develop a personal relationship with Jesus Christ to the point where the heart is completely yielded to His control. The Bible makes it clear that there are attitudes and actions that are not to be part of a Christian's life. Negative characteristics are to be replaced by their godly opposite (Ephesians 4:22-32; Colossians 3:8-14).

Students are expected to abide by the following standards of conduct throughout their enrollment whether at home, school, or elsewhere. This includes school vacations and the months of summer. The behaviors listed are not meant to be considered an exhaustive list of all the guidelines of the school. They serve as a reflection of the types of actions that result in school discipline.

Offenses include cheating, using indecent language, swearing, and inappropriate dress. More serious actions include smoking, drinking alcoholic beverages, using narcotics, immorality, dancing, and gambling. Major offenses will result in significant discipline and could result in expulsion.

I agree to abide by the above standards of conduct and other regulations expected of each student enrolled in Faith Christian School. I will not give the impression to other students or the faculty that I am out of harmony with the goals, aims, and standards of the school. I realize that infractions may cause me to lose my good standing in the school and could even jeopardize my enrollment.

I agree to not make demands, threaten to sue, make any kind of accusation or complaint, or actually litigate any matter whatsoever relating to or resulting from the enforcement of the Standard of Conduct.

PARENT'S PLEDGE

1. By signing this application, we accept willingly the Statement of Faith and the objectives of Faith Christian School: we whole-heartedly subscribe to them and are willing to have our child trained in accordance with them. We view our child's attendance at Faith Christian School as a God-given privilege and not a right.
2. Our child is expected to pledge allegiance to the Bible, as God's Holy Word; to the Christian Flag, symbolic of our heavenly heritage; and to the American Flag, the symbol of our present God-given patriotic heritage.
3. We furthermore invest authority in the school to discipline our child as necessary, including corporal punishment. A copy of our policy is available for your review. We will discipline our child at home as needed (Proverbs 13:24; 19:18; 22:6; 23:13, 14; 29:15, 17; Ephesians 6:13; Colossians 3:20; Hebrews 12:6).
4. We understand that assessments will be made to cover damage to school property such as breaking of windows, defacing furniture, abusing books, etc. if our child is responsible.
5. We agree that if our child should become involved in any trouble with other children in the school, we will in no case complain to any parent, but, in Christian love and with prayer, we will register only necessary complaints with the teacher or administrator.
6. Should our child experience any serious difficulties at school, we shall seek counsel of the child's teacher first, then the administration, and, if needed, the school board.
7. We understand the school reserves the right to dismiss our child for not respecting its spiritual standards or cooperating with the total educational program. All students are expected to obey the spirit and specifics of the Standard of Conduct.
8. The administration has full responsibility for placing our child in the proper grade.
9. Our child has our permission to go on all scheduled, supervised field trips and other sponsored activities. At times there may be a small fee relating to field trips.
10. The registration fee is due with this application. The application cannot be processed without it. No refunds are made on approved applications.
11. All tuition payments are due on the 15th of each month, beginning in the month of August and continuing through the month of May. Our child may be dismissed from school if our account is delinquent over thirty (30) days unless other arrangements are made in writing and approved by the Board. There will be no deductions or refunds due to holidays or absences. Tuition will be refunded for students who withdraw or are expelled for months which the tuition has already been paid. This does not apply to the month of withdrawal or expulsion, based on an August 15-September 14 format.
12. We will give assistance to the school with faithful prayers for FCS, practical help as needs are known, punctual tuition payments, and monetary contributions when possible as tuition covers about 75% of the school's budget.
13. In full cooperation with the school, we will attend the Parent-Teacher Fellowship meetings. We sincerely pledge our loyalty to the aims and ideals of the school and will bring any/all questions and criticisms directly to the administration so that they may be properly considered by those in authority.
